Fogarty EDvance has worked with 125 schools to improve academic outcomes for over 58,000 students across Western Australia.

During the program around 60% of schools in the first six EDvance cohorts have achieved a **significant improvement** in student outcomes on NAPLAN or school completion measures.

Every school that has completed the School Improvement Program has seen improvement particularly in areas such as student engagement, community engagement and the school culture.


This makes the EDvance program one of the most successful school improvement programs in Australia, with evidence of improved student outcomes at a whole school level.

## How is EDvance different to other professional development programs?

The Fogarty EDvance School Improvement Program is school leader driven, context specific and adaptable. Over three years, the key focus is to support school leaders to identify and implement effective practice into their specific school context, and positively impact student outcomes.



## The three year journey – what does it involve?



At the conclusion of the three year program, your school will be part of the growing FED Alumni Network and continue to be supported and celebrated as you progress further on your school improvement journey.

## How does it work in your school?

### Principal and Leadership Team

- ▶ You will bring members of staff that represent the leadership structure in your school to each of the workshops and attend all strategic meetings
- ▶ You will focus on your school's performance and learn about organisational health and building leadership capacity and capability
- ▶ Together, your team will lead the design of a program of change and implement it

### Whole Staff

- ▶ You will use a range of diagnostic tools to deeply understand the experiences and perspectives of staff (and key stakeholders) in your school
- ▶ Work with the whole staff to develop your plan and program of change



### Focus on Student Outcomes

You will track the difference you make to students educational experience in your school over three years

# How much does it cost?

Thanks to our generous funding partners, schools are able to join the program for less than the annual cost

(Program value: \$30,000 per school per annum).

School contribution per annum\*  
(for each year of the program):

- **Primary Schools \$12,000+GST**
- **District High Schools \$13,500+GST**
- **Secondary Schools \$20,000+GST**

Additional variable cost recovery for schools outside the Perth metro area of \$2,500 - \$10,000 (calculated on request for individual schools)
